

## DRESS CODE POLICY

- No crop, tank, mesh, see-through, halter tops, or spaghetti straps may be worn.
- The midriff area must be covered at all times.
- Physical Education uniforms are to be worn in P.E. only.
- No short shorts or fitted shorts such as bicycle pants are allowed. Fitted shorts may be worn under a pair of loose shorts. All shorts, skirts, and dresses must be longer than the student's fingertips when the arms are held straight down at the side.
- No clothing may be worn which contains working designed to draw attention to certain body parts.
- Underwear and undergarments of any type shall be covered at all times.
- Boys may not wear white t-shirts/undershirts or sleeveless shirts.
- No hats, caps, head stockings/do-rags, athletic style headbands, bandannas, head kerchiefs are allowed AT ANY TIME on campus. These items will be confiscated by a teacher or administrator and returned only to a parent or guardian.
- The hoods of jackets or sweatshirts may not be worn inside the building.
- No backless shoes, bedroom slippers, flip-flops, or high heels are allowed for safety reasons. Shoes with laces must be laced and tied at all times. No Heelys allowed (shoes with wheels)
- This jackets and sweatshirts are allowed in the building. Students will place heavy coats worn to school in their locked lockers.
- No gloves may be worn in the building.
- No pajamas are allowed.
- No beachwear is allowed.
- No sunglasses may be worn or displayed in the building.
- Pants will be worn at the waist.
- Clothes that advertise alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs, or other suggestive messages/merchandise (i.e. weapons, sexual or racial references, profanity) are not permitted.
- Leggings/Jeggings and spandex may not be worn as an outer garment. Shorts or a skirt of proper length must be worn over them.
